

## FOGGY RIVER SHORT COURSE SCHOOLING EVENTS

Welcome to a new sport which compliments the sport of Horse Trials. This new sport called Short Course Eventing expands the Combined Test concept and also includes Cross Country type fences in an expanded Stadium course. Riders begin with a Dressage test, followed by a combined Stadium and Cross Country jumping course. Jumping begins with Stadium fences on our grass jumping ring, then without stopping, continues out of the ring over solid and knock down jumps, banks, ditches and back into the ring to finish over more stadium fences.

The Foggy River Short Courses offer four levels of competition, each increasing in distance and difficulty. [Jumping efforts listed below are Stadium and Cross Country combined.](#)

<u>Level</u>	<u>Distance</u>	<u>Max Height</u>	<u>Jumping Efforts</u> (Approx.)
<b>Pre-Entry</b>	600 m.	2'4" (70cm)	11-12
<b>Entry</b>	1200 m.	2'8" (80cm)	15-16
<b>Pre-Training</b>	1600 m.	3'0 (90cm)	18-20
<b>Training</b>	1800 m.	3'3"	20-22

### Scoring and Rules

Dressage tests will be the current CADORA tests posted on this website. Jump heights and dimensions as per current event levels. Times will be assigned for Dressage tests and Jumping Phase.

Jumping Phase: There will be an audible signal to start. No salute is required.

Knock down -4, 1<sup>st</sup> refusal -20, 2<sup>nd</sup> refusal at same fence -40, 3<sup>rd</sup> refusal at same fence E. Fall of horse E, Fall of rider 65pp, 5 refusals in whole course E. Continuation of course after E is according to the discretion of the judge. Combinations numbered AB or ABC will be as per Stadium rules, ie: if B is refused A must be re-jumped on second presentation. All circles on course will be scored as refusals. Dressage score in penalty points (lower the better). Jump penalties added to dressage penalty points to determine final score. Ties are broken by going back to dressage score.

Tack and Dress will be as per EC Horse Trials rules with the addition of the following:

- ❑ Dress for Jumping: jackets and body protectors optional, shirts must have sleeves and collars (no sleeveless shirts). Boots and breeches to be worn, no Full Chaps. (Half chaps permitted with proper jodhpur boots.)
- ❑ There are no tack checks, however; an official can inspect tack if one is suspect of illegal equipment.
